Investment Opportunities in the Blue Economy

The ocean is the Earth's largest ecosystem and hosts most life, predominantly microscopic organisms, but also the blue whale, the largest animal that has ever lived on Earth. It is estimated that the oceans are home to over two million different species, and as much as 91 percent of marine life remains to be discovered.

However, we do know that the ocean is in crisis. The amount of fish, sea birds, whales and other marine species has been reduced by as much as 50 percent in only 40 years. This is a much more acute situation than previously anticipated, requiring immediate action at both the national and international level – a global rescue operation is needed.

Solutions exist, and we can turn the tide on this degradation. With this event, we want to shed light on the opportunities for business and private initiatives in saving our ocean.
